Training/Orientation for American Red Cross (ARC) National Spiritual Care Response

Tuesday, February 7, 9:00am–4:00p and Wednesday, February 8, 9:00am–4:00pm

A 2-day (12 hours total) Training Seminar. Beginning with the Family Assistance Act of 1996 and with Pastoral Care Certifying Collegiate Groups ARC has activated a Spiritual Care component to ARC Critical Response Team (CRT). This seminar will engage REM and ACPE members interested in CRT Activation by ARC in the basic information and orientation to work with the ARC in national transportation accident response as well as national and regional Disaster Response. CPE and membership in ACPE or one of the cognate Pastoral Care groups (NACC, APC, NAJC, ICPC, CPSP, etc.) is required. There is no charge for this training, however, space is limited and early registration required.
