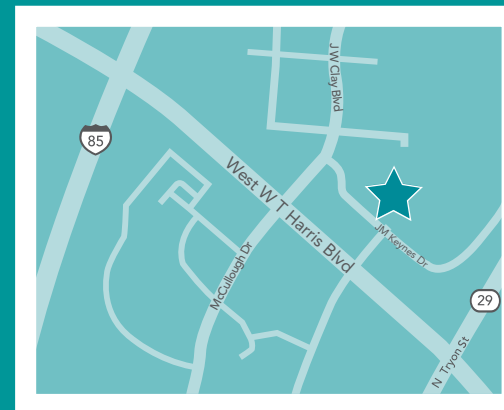

OVERVIEW

This 100-hour course will use proven integrative medicine therapies to enhance the integration of chaplaincy skills for Board-Certified Chaplains and experienced chaplains who work in healthcare. In session one, attendees will learn the nuances and intricacies of:

- Healing touch
- Mindfulness
- Acupuncture
- Mindful self-compassion
- Aromatherapy
- Breath prayer
- Massage therapy
- Guided imagery
- Holistic care in trauma
- Evidence-based practice

Session one also covers how to use these therapies in direct ministry with patients or make referrals to other qualified specialists.

Session two covers more integrative healing therapies and includes presentations to a peer group.

Up to 20 students can be accommodated in the Integrative Chaplain Certificate Course. Admission will be on a first-come, first-served basis.
